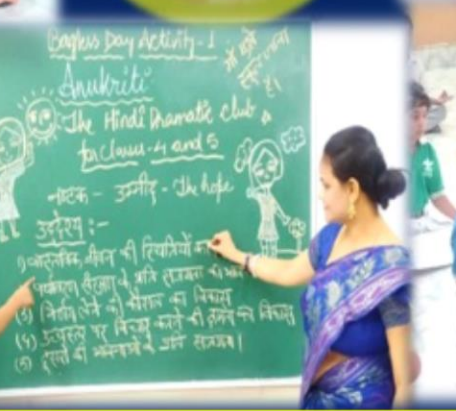
# BAGLESS DAY

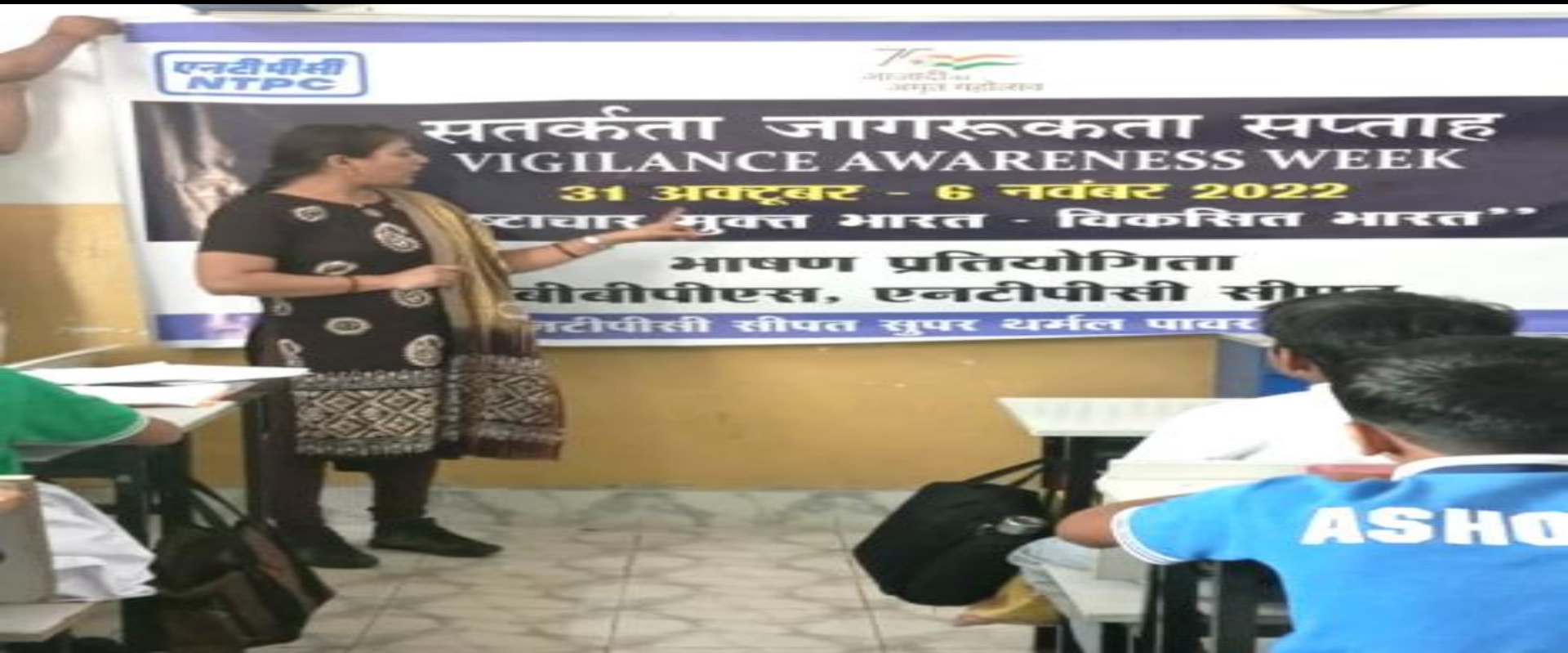
# VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK
