# PARENT ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

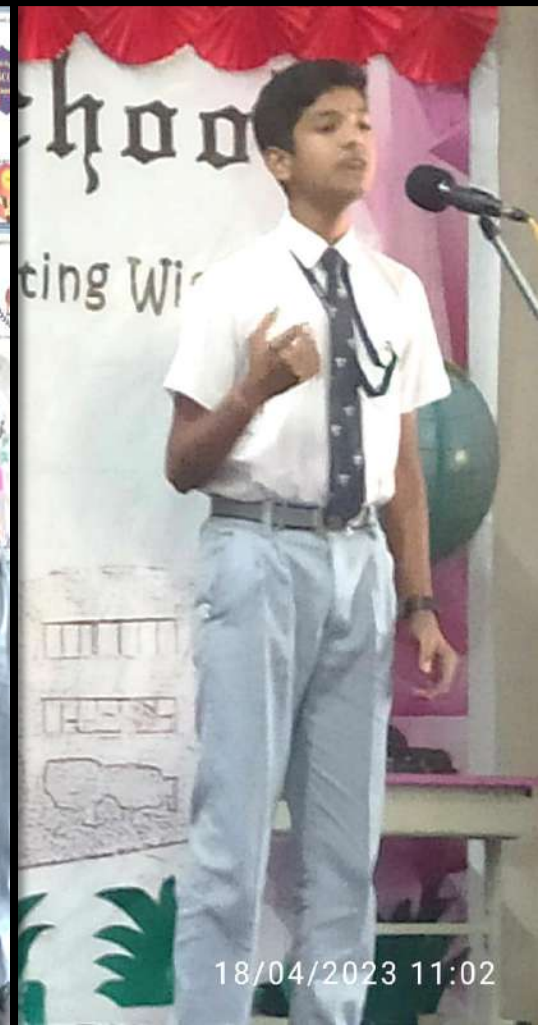
