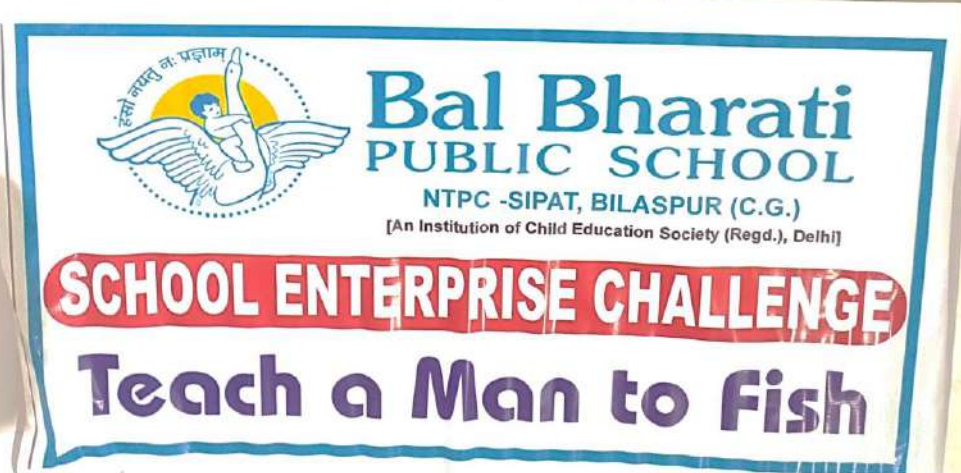
MISSION READING

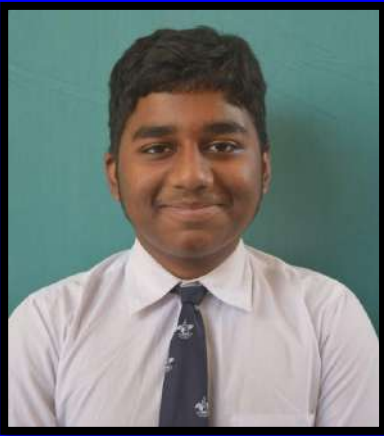
